Crime Updates (Feb)

Offence	Numbers	What could this entail
Arson	0	Damage caused as a result of fire.
Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)	0	Harassment, alarm or distress is caused in a non-crime incident.
Burglary non dwelling (BOTD)	0	A person commits theft in a building or structure that is not lived in.
Burglary dwelling	3	Entry and theft in a building or a structure that is lived in.
Criminal Damage	2	A person destroys or damages property belonging to someone else.
Domestic	2	Domestic incidents where a crime has not occurred. Parties are aged 16 or over and have been intimate partners or family members regardless of sexuality.
Hate Incident	0	Any incident where a crime has not occurred which the victim, or anyone else, thinks is based on someone's prejudice towards them because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or because they are transgender.
Race or Religious aggravated public fear	0	Any crime determined to have a hate element as per above.
Possession of controlled substance	0	Unlawful possession of a drug classified in class A, B or C.
Possession of weapons	0	Unlawful possession of an article used as a weapon.
Public fear, alarm or distress	1	Public order offences e.g. from a verbal altercation to offences just short of violence.
Robbery	0	Includes a range of offences where force is used, threatened or the victim is put in fear.
Theft from a motor vehicle	0	Any item stolen that was in, on or attached to a motor vehicle.
Theft or unauthorised taking of a motor vehicle	0	Any motor vehicle including those abandoned.
Theft of pedal cycle	0	From a public place, if stolen from a shed or garage this would be a BOTD.
Theft from a person	1	Purse being taken from a handbag, or a mobile phone from a shopping basket.



Message from your Engagement Officer

I am keen to support residents associations—having a direct link can fast track information sharing and enhance the way we deliver our service. If you are involved with a residents group please get in touch so I can be involved too.

If you want to report specific non emergency issues please dial 101. Explain what the issue is and the area you live. This can then be passed to a relevant officer in that area.

What is happening in your area

Next month we will hold a consultation with local councillors and community representatives to canvass opinions on what is affecting you where you live. This data will then be collated and put to a public vote through social media to identify a policing priority, to begin in May. This process has been really successful in other areas and details about the process will be released shortly.

Neighbourhood Priorities

The team have made significant arrests in relation to a recent spate of dwelling and commercial burglaries and this will see the high figures reported drop significantly going into the new period. This focus will continue with attention being paid to the Golden Triangle areas. Please be vigilant and report suspicious activity. Some burglars choose to act in broad daylight so bear this in mind and be on the look out as you are our eyes and ears.
