Dear resident,

Transport for Norwich: 20mph speed restriction and traffic calming

We are proposing to install a 20mph speed restriction in residential areas to the south of Norwich to improve road safety. A plan showing the extent of this restriction is printed on the back of this letter.

To encourage compliance, it is necessary to install traffic calming on Church Lane and Greenways. The traffic calming will consist of a pedestrian refuge, priority giveways, junction layout changes and white painted 20 roundels on the road surface.

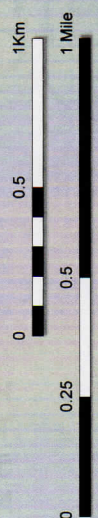
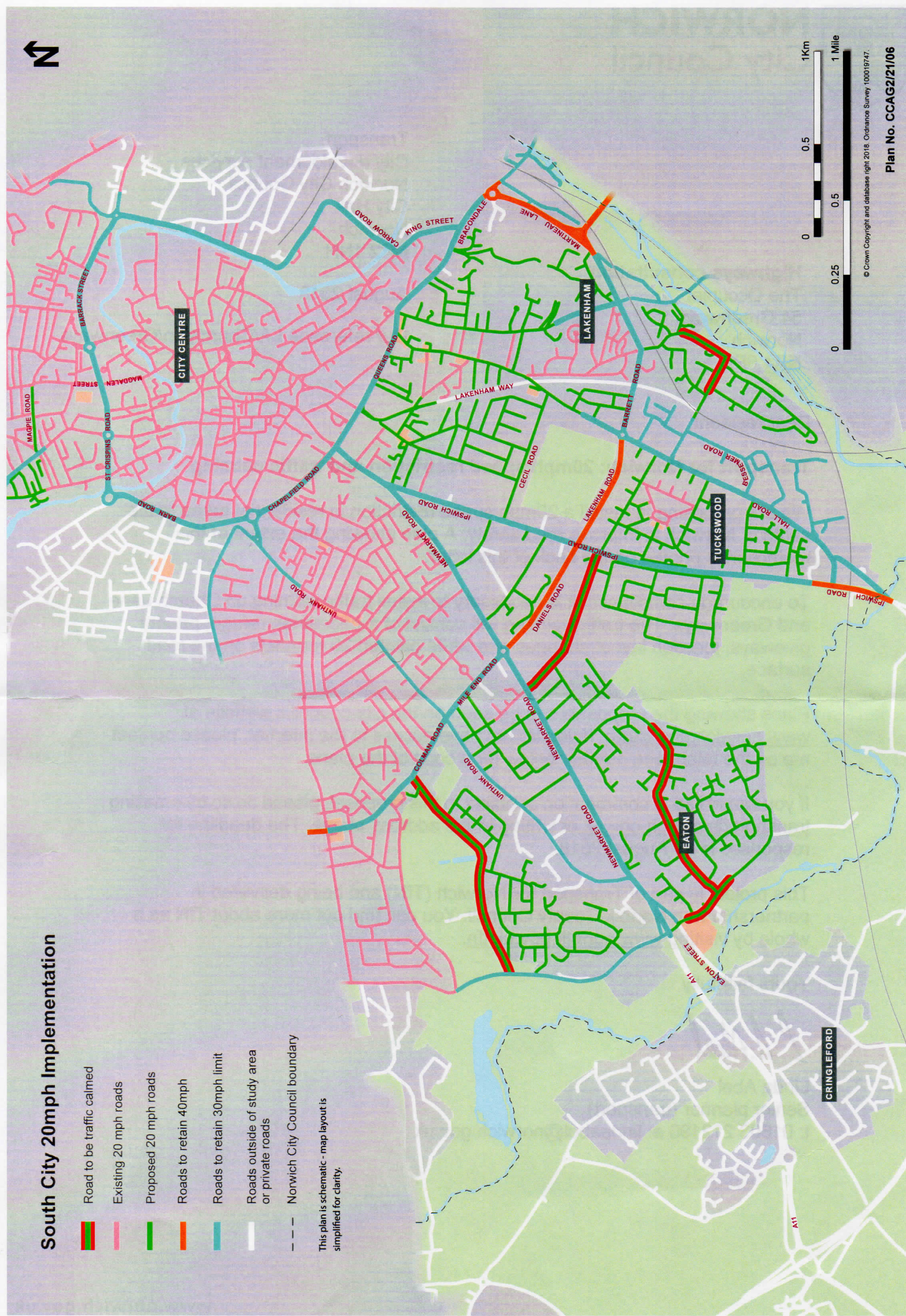
