

St Andrew's Eaton Church Hall Refurbishment

Active consideration is being given to the refurbishment of St Andrew's Hall.

The hall was built in the early 1960's and consequently we plan a considerable amount of work to bring it up to modern day, environmentally friendly standards. Refurbishment will include, amongst other things, new heating and lighting, better toilets, a commercial kitchen, internet and inbuilt audio-visual facilities suitable for talks, showing films etc.

We hope to develop an easier, on-line, booking system and easier access to the hall once booked.
